© Eligibility

1) Master's Program & Integrated Master and Doctoral Program

- Applicants having obtained (or expected to obtain) a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent in Korea or an overseas country

2) Doctoral Program

- Applicants having obtained (or expected to obtain) a Master's degree in related fields or its equivalent in Korea or an overseas country

© Documents required

1) **Master's Program & Integrated Master and Doctoral Program**

- ① One copy of the GSIAS online application form
 - overseas applicants: a separate form at <http://gsias.hufs.ac.kr>
- ② Bachelor's degree certificate and transcript (1 original version of each)
 - must be **officially translated*** into Korean or English
 - * This means translation certified by a consular officer, licensed translator, or other official body.
 - If your degree certificate or transcripts cannot be re-issued by your university please have the copy of the certificate(or transcript) collated or authenticated by the university and submit them instead of the originals. (**Note:** Submitted materials will not be returned.)
- ③ Research proposal (form available after online application)
- ④ Certificate of the Bank Deposit (International Applicants Only/**Optional**)
 - more than 10,000 US\$ of yourself or family members
 - original certificate issued by a bank
- ⑤ One copy of passport

2) **Doctoral Program**

- ① One copy of the GSIAS online application form
 - overseas applicants: a separate form at <http://gsias.hufs.ac.kr>
- ② Master's degree certificate (1 original version)
 - must be **officially translated*** into Korean or English
 - If your degree certificate or transcripts cannot be re-issued by your university please have the copy of the certificate(or transcript) collated or authenticated by the university and submit them instead of the originals. (**Note:** Submitted materials will not be returned.)

- ③ Transcripts of Undergraduate and Graduate Studies (1 original version of each)
 - must be **officially translated*** into Korean or English
 - *This means translation certified by a consular officer, licensed translator, or other official body.*
- ④ Research proposal (form available after online application)
- ⑤ Master's Thesis example (or research papers)
- ⑥ Certificate of the Bank Deposit (International Applicants Only/**Optional**)
 - more than 10,000 US\$ of yourself or family members
 - original certificate issued by a bank
- ⑦ One copy of passport

- Applicants should fill in the application form online and send printed version to the Administrative Office of GSIAS (postal submission accepted).
- Original degree certificates and transcripts issued from overseas countries must be **officially translated*** into Korean or English.
**This means translation certified by a consular officer, licensed translator, or other official body.*
- Submission by mail should be registered and arrive by the due date.
- **Submitted materials will not be returned.**
- **For overseas applicants**
 - i) If you have difficulty in applying online please download the separate form at <http://gsias.hufs.ac.kr> and send your application package early enough to meet the

deadline. GSIAS will do the online application on behalf of you after receiving your package.

- ii) If you are not able to attend the admission interview in person, please email hufsgsias@hufs.ac.kr to request for a phone interview, which can be allowed upon approval by each department.
