- C. Needs score in authorized English qualification exam more than FLEX 901/1500, FLEX 620/1000, TOEIC 700, TOEFL CBT 197, TOEFL iBT 71, or TEPS 625

2) Doctoral Program: Applicants required one of below;

- A. Having obtained (or expected to obtain) a J.D. degree
- B. Lawyers in Korea or an overseas country with a master's degree

C. Applicants recognized having equivalent eligibility mentioned above
